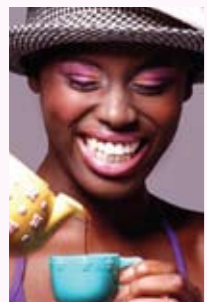
Ten experts reveal their couldn't-live-without-it beauty products



MIA KILBY, MODEL
Beauty must-have: Rimmel Exaggerate Liquid Eye Liner in Black (£4.99, Boots).
 “Whenever I’ve got a shoot or want to emphasise my eyes, I use Rimmel’s Exaggerate Liquid Eye Liner. It stays on all day and is really easy to apply. To get the look I love, I apply it in a long, dramatic line, sweeping from the inside corner of the eyelash line, to a flicked end at the outside corner. It gives my eyes a cat-like quality.”





SYMARA TEMPLEMAN, MODEL
Beauty must-have: St Ives Apricot Invigorating Facial Scrub (£4.29, Superdrug).
 “My skin’s naturally soft and silky, but spots soon start appearing if I don’t take care of it. To combat this, I use the Apricot Invigorating Facial Scrub every night before going to sleep. I apply just enough to cover my face and wash it off with warm water. Doing it more than once a day



would dry the skin, as it’s an abrasive exfoliator, but single use daily leaves my face smooth, refreshed and clear.”

CHLOE-JASMINE WICHELO, MODEL
Beauty must-have: Kérastase Oleo-Relax Nuit (£25.30, for stockists, call 0800 3164400).
 “I’ve got completely wild hair, but the Oleo-Relax Nuit controls it fantastically and I highly recommend it for women with wavy or curly hair. Regularly going on shoots means my hair’s often overloaded with product, but applying just two pea-sized drops of Oleo-Relax Nuit on the ends of my hair after towel-drying it, gives me 72 hours of anti-frizz protection.”

JO CRAIG, MAKE-UP ARTIST
Beauty must-have: MAC Mineralize Skinfinish Highlighter (£19.50, for stockists, call 0870 0342676).

“It’s got a great metallic-sheen finish and, although it’s expensive, it lasts a long time, so it’s really worth the money. To apply, use a small or angled blusher brush and add just a tiny amount to the tops of your cheeks. Avoid putting it on the apples of the cheeks, though. You can also use it on the ends of the brow bone – apply with a small eyeshadow brush or with your finger to make the area look bigger and define your eyebrows.”




RHEA LE RICHE, MAKE-UP ARTIST AND HAIR STYLIST
Beauty must-have: Stila Duo Brow Set in Dark (£12, Stila Cosmetics.com).
 “Every single day, for the last five years since I first discovered it, I’ve used this and I’m yet to find a better brow



product. The eyebrows are really important in balancing the face and this set is great because it comes with two shades that allow you to create your own shape. It’s easy to form a soft shape or a dramatic brow. Apply it using a good eyebrow brush, like the Laura Mercier Double-ended Eyebrow Brush (£28, Space.NK), for precision. The slight green undertone in these shades makes it ideal for people with natural brown hairs.”




BECCA GRAY, NAIL TECHNICIAN
Beauty must-have: Sally Hansen Maximum Growth Cuticle and Nail Treatment (£2.99, Amazon.co.uk).
 “This oil’s great for helping your nails grow and keeping your cuticles soft, so even if you pick or bite them, they still look well-moisturised and healthy. It’s also designed like a pen, so it’s easy to use on the go as there’s no hassle or mess. Even if you paint your nails a lot, or have falsies, you can still use this treatment.”

“I use this organic concealer without fail every day. It contains cocoa seed, which is packed full of antioxidants, and blends into the skin perfectly, just by using a tapping motion with the finger. It’s great for reducing puffy morning eyes and I use it as a primer on the lids to help eyeshadows last all day. It also works as a light foundation to

hide redness. It’s simple to use and leaves a flawless complexion without looking ‘caked’ and dehydrated.”



SHANNEL WATSON, HAIR EXTENSIONIST
Beauty must-have: Secret Extensions Natural Hair Extensions (starting from £420, for salons, call 020 3292 0431).
 “My hair’s naturally quite thin, so to transform it into my defining feature without damaging it, I use these extensions. They make my hair look strikingly long and thick and they’re great for adding colour.”



LUCY BROWN, MAKE-UP ARTIST
Beauty must-have: Estée Lauder Advanced Night Repair Serum (£36, EsteeLauder.co.uk).
 “Preparing the skin before applying



make-up is an essential part of my routine, and this is what I use. Its anti-aging formula – which has been created based on DNA research – helps calm, hydrate and protect skin tone. Ideally, it should be used once a day, but I use it morning and night. Just smooth four or five drops over the face before moisturising.”



SHAVATA SINGH, EYELASH/BROW GURU
Beauty must-have: Guerlain Le 2 de Guerlain Two Brush Mascara (£23.50, Debenhams).
 “I use this to vamp up my lashes. The large brush gives volume and length to the upper lashes and the small one distinguishes the lower lashes without bleeding mascara onto the cheek. If I’m going out, I always apply Shavata Plain Strip Lashes (£7, Lash Lounge) for additional drama.”
